Residents and Guests, including children over 2, must present badges to the pool operator and sign the Registration Book upon entering pool area – <u>ADDRESS WILL BE VERIFIED &</u> <u>SIGNATURE MUST BE LEGIBLE. IF YOU ARE ON THE NON-ELIGIBLE LIST YOU</u>

WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ENTRY AND USE OF THE POOL. RESIDENTS THAT HAVE LOST THEIR BADGE WILL BE REFERRED TO THE OFFICE, THERE IS <u>A \$20 FEE TO REPLACE LOST BADGES</u>. IF IT'S A WEEKEND YOU WILL RECEIVE A <u>ONE TIME</u> BADGE THAT WEEKEND. CONTACT THE OFFICE ON MONDAY TO PURCHASE REPLACEMENT BADGES.

 - Any person who is incontinent including children who are not potty trained, must wear

appropriate waterproof clothing.

- 5. ABSOLUTELY NO RUNNING OR ROUGH HOUSING IN THE POOL/CLUBHOUSE.
- 6. Pool and surrounding area will be closed during electrical storms.
